Sandra Knipe stated that the tank does not need to be expensive, but does need to be separate from the current septic system in order to keep it from failing as the chemicals going into the system are considered "Industrial Wastewater".

The Board recommended that Lori consult with a plumber for an estimate and then contact Shilpi Desai to see if she would be willing to work with her financially.

Lori will get back to the Board within a few weeks.
