

**Hubbardston Board of Health
November 23, 2010
Minutes
Library Basement**

Meeting opened at 7:00PM in Hubbardston Library Conference Room located in the Library basement.

Old Business: Mike Stevens, Chairman of the Conservation Commission was present, and gave an update on the gravel pit on Pitcherville Road. As there were building materials found in what has been brought in and spread including ground up particle board, masonite countertops, caulking tubes, pressure treated lumber, paint chips and formica, testing will be done and paid for by J. Paul Routhier & Sons, Inc. Mike will be contacting engineer Dave Klinch regarding the testing. Mike said Jim Fletcher is cooperative and had given keys to him. Mike said they did put in swales and they are willing to put down rubber and stockpile the material until the results come in.

Sandra Knipe went with the DEP and noted that 7-10% of material that was "not clean". Mike stated he walked 3 miles of it and that it was much more than that and said there were 4 acres already spread 6" deep.

The company has stated the material was put there for different reasons including: reclamation, erosion control, and making mulch. DEP and the Town should have been notified beforehand, but wasn't. Mike will keep the Board informed.

The Board entered into a discussion regarding options moving forward, but want to work together with the other town Boards as soon as sample results are received.

Landfill Results: Julian Vortuba presented Landfill results on the monitoring wells. Results were found to be fine as far as drinking water standards. Iron and Manganese were slightly elevated while VOC's were the same as prior tests.

POA: Sandra will call Alpha Analytical laboratory regarding the VOC's.

Wide Angle Marketing: Craig Kaijala & Chris Knuth came before the Board regarding a review of septic plans that have been revised for 27 Old Colony Road.

As it has been since June 2009 and plan never was submitted to the state, the system has been made smaller, but the variances are the same. They plan to start the project in the Spring of 2011 if approved by Matt Hopkinson. The Board was presented with two plans, a LUA form and an application for the DWCP.
