Request for PWS Expansion

Mr. Mike's Hubbardston is requesting that the MassDEP allow the facility to perform minor renovation that would allow the store to incorporate food preparation (including a deli area, a small pizza oven and a self-contained frying station) as well as the continued sale of coffee and fountain drinks. Currently the store is approved for an average daily volume of 500 gallons per day (gpd) from the existing source well. The renovation will not create flows in excess of the annual average daily volume of 500 gpd that has been approved for Well 02; there is no action that is required from the BOH at this time.

Seasonal Influenza Vaccine Reimbursement

The 2011 flu clinics for the town were held October 29, November 5, and November 29, 2011. All filings for reimbursement for the vaccines administered by the town should have been mailed within 30 days of service. Any forms for reimbursement received past that time are not guaranteed reimbursement. At this point no filings have been submitted. The town has entered into an agreement with the University of Massachusetts to submit the paper work needed to receive reimbursement, there is a 10% fee involved for each submission. This agreement has been signed by the Board of Selectman and once UMass enters into the agreement the proper medical forms will be forwarded.

11 Evergreen Road

Notification of a welfare check was completed on the home located at 11 Evergreen Road in regards to the children on February 13, 2012 by Sgt. Newton. The Department of Children and Families have been contacted and no further action is required by the Board of Health.

15 Main Street

Matt Hopkinson reviewed the resubmission of the septic design plan for 15 Main Street with corrections noted. It was found to have addressed the missing information and was approved. The LUA dated September 13, 2011 was updated with Valerie Daigle as design engineer and owner Stacy Strangos.

There were no vouchers to be reviewed or signed. One permit for a tanning device permit was signed for Lori Mustakangos.
