Vouchers:

Permits:

New Business:

While reviewing phone bills during preparation for the budget planning process the BOS noticed that the Town has paid \$399.89 to date for the individual fax line for the BOH office to receive a total of 13 faxes over the past twelve months. The BOS respectfully requested that the BOH discontinue the use of the additional fax in the BOH office, all members were in agreement and were in favor of the request.

The annual Marine and Fresh Water report was reviewed.

Recycle Center

A new roll-off trash container was delivered prior to opening on Saturday the 9th of June. The roll - off will be used for furniture and other debris that is left illegally on days that the center is closed. The supplier Son of Kristoff agrees to waive the fifty dollar a month rental fee and will only charge for the emptying of the container.

Public Water Supply

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) Drinking Water Program (DWP) annually provides local boards of health with information of interest and an inventory of all public water systems (PWS) for review and comment. The documents were received and annual updated forms were forwarded to DEP for the year 2012.

2012-2013 Seasonal Flu Update

Notification was received from DPH regarding allocation of flu vaccine for the coming flu season. 120 - 0.5 ml (10 dose vial) and 20 - 0.2 ml FluMist will be dispense sometime between August and November of this year.

Cauldron Farms

The board discussed the untimely death of a twenty-four year old male from a drug overdose that occurred at the farm. The board received information regarding the operations of Cauldron Farms for other possible BOH issues, and questions were raised as to whether the farm was possibly operating as a campground facility without a campground license.

Pine Street

A resident located at the condominiums located on Pine Street has by her own admission been selling hedge hogs and possible other small animals. The board cited its by-law dealing with pet shops and the need to have a annual permit to conduct business. The resident will be forwarded a copy of the by-lay and requested to attend the June 26, 2012 meeting.
