**Library Basement**

Board of Health meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Hubbardston Library Conference Room located in the Library Basement.

**First order of Business:**

The Board of Health needed to elect a Chairman and Vice Chairman. Steve Mossey nominated Tomas Larson as Chairman of the Board of Health. Mr. Larson accepted the nomination. Randy Mizereck nominated Lucinda Oates as Vice Chairman of the Board of Health. L. Oates was not in attendance to accept the nomination but a motion was put forward.

**Motion made to nominate Lucinda Oates as Vice Chairman of the Board of Health pending her acceptance of the position. All in favor, motion carries.**

**Flu Clinic:**

A Rite Aid representative came into the office to let the Board know that Rite Aid is willing to come in to do a flu clinic for the town at no charge to the BOH. The clinic would be comparable to how the BOH ran it. The residents would come to the Senior Center and bring their insurance cards and would be given a flu vaccine. The clinic would be for those 18 and older. No children under 18 will be allowed for vaccines due to liability. The State is not supplying flu vaccines any longer for the BOH to distribute. There are no funds in the budget to purchase vaccines. Rite Aid is also offering to go to any shut-ins and also for the Hubbardston House. A discussion ensued regarding how much the people of Hubbardston appreciate the Flu Clinic and how the BOH would like to continue somehow to be able to fund this. The Board asked that Toni find out the cost of the vaccine if we purchased them outright for 130 doses as well as the cost if we do just the kids. Once the price is found out, Hayden Duggan will draft a letter to the State asking if they could reduce the cost or if there is anything else we can do to still provide this service to the Town.

**Second: Steve Mossey**

**Motion made for Hayden Duggan to look into how the BOH could get doses of the vaccine to make available for everyone in the town. All in favor, motion carries.**

**Abandoned Housing Program:**

Larry Brandt, the Building Inspector, chose three houses that meet the criteria for the program. Lucinda Oates, who was on the team to visit the properties, was not able to attend tonight's meeting therefore we could not get her input. Randy Mizereck asked if letters had been sent to the owners regarding this program. There was only one person who responded to the notices, which were sent registered mail, to inform us that they no longer own the property as it had been foreclosed on. R. Mizereck would like to hear from Lucinda Oates as to what she saw at the properties. The Board would like to table the discussion until Lucinda Oates is available to update the Board. Chairman Larson said that there are other programs for the owners of the properties to look into for help before they get put into this program. Discussion is tabled.
