The Hubbardston Historical Commission met with Gary Kangas, Ken Green, Charles Clark, Barbara Carpenter, Associate member Hilary Scott and Martha Holgerson. Also present were Cynthia Doane, Carol Whitney and James Pitney to notarize our signatures.

A motion was made to accept the Historical Preservation Agreement between the town of Hubbardston and the Unitarian Church and have the signatures notarized by those of the Historical Commission authorized to sign. The vote was unanimous.

The Secretary's report was accepted as read with the correction referring to the meeting with the Cemetery Commission to include the placing of the flag pole.

The letter from the Town Secretary about removing our cabinet and books was not received in time to be put on our agenda. We will investigate our alternatives at our next meeting. The Secretary will meet with the Town Administrator about options.

We were notified by Chris Skelly that the State law passed allowing local historical commissions alternate members and allowing them to vote if a member is absent. The Secretary will meet with the Town Administrator about this, as they would have to be appointed and sworn in.

Hilary Scott reported the Antiquarian Society in Worcester will be open 10 to 12 on February 22nd. with papers on view about the 1774 revolution. Ken will go and try to get information on Hubbardston's militia. Hilary also reported Ann Gobi would like to help with the funding of the militia. He will contact her.

Gary will contact the Historical Society to extend an invitation to attend our March 6 meeting to discuss the Hubbardston Militia etc.

The Secretary will also discuss with the Town Administrator our two file cabinets and the Wain-Roy signs we wish to put up on Route 68.
