7:00 p.m. Public Hearing for Hubbardston Highway Department postponed to meeting to be held on March 10, 2010 because of the storm yesterday

7:15 p.m. Public Hearing on Request for Determination of Applicability for Roger and Claudia Provencal for a subsurface disposal design at 19 Thompson Road, Hubbardston, Ma.

Mike Pond met with the Commission to discuss the plans for the subsurface disposal design at 19 Thompson Road in Hubbardston. After looking at the plan, a motion was made. **Motion:** Mike Stevens, to accept the plan presented entitled Subsurface Disposal Design dated 1-15-10 and to issue a Negative 3 determination. **Seconded:** Steve Mossey **Vote:** All in favor with the stipulation that all excavated material is to be stored away from the wetlands and hay bales and silt fence is to be used to prevent erosion.

7:23 p.m. Timothy McEnary of Wish Me Luck Stables to address concerns about creating new open fields in the wetlands

Tim McEnary came in at the request of the Conservation Commission to answer some concerns they had about the surrounding wetlands. Tim explained to the members that he has created no new fields. The red barn is now gone and has opened up the fields and he has cleaned up a lot of storm damage making the fields appear larger. Mr. McEnary mentioned that where the water runs from across the street into his land he would like to stabilize with a catch basin with a lot of riprap preventing the catch rock in the front, slowing down the flow so the vegetation can grow back and slow the flow. The Commission agreed.

7:40 p.m. Mark Johnson and his wife of 12 Upper Intervale Road came in to discuss the wetlands on their property.

The Johnsons came in to discuss an alleged wetland violation on their property. Joe Bellino of the Central Region Office of Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and Mike Stevens visited the property at 12 Upper Intervale Road and it was their opinion that the Johnsons needed to file a Notice of Intent for the work they were doing in the wetlands. Mark Johnson said they would be filing a Notice of Intent and a map showing the wetlands on their property.
