<p>7:00 p.m. Lyn Gauthier met with the Commission to inform them about the repairs of the drainage system on a section of New Templeton Road and guard rail replacement on Evergreen Road.</p>

Lyn Gauthier, Highway Superintendent, presented a letter describing the scheduled drainage maintenance and structure replacement on New Templeton Road from Route 68 to the first swamp for September encompassing approximately 3700'.

The work to be done is:

1. Replace approximately 350' of cross culvert pipe.
2. Replace 8 hand built catch basins with pre-cast structures.
3. Install 8 head walls on the output of the cross culvert.
4. Install Rip Rap at the output of the cross culverts.
5. Install Hay Bales on each end of the cross culverts.
6. Swale and slope the east side of New Templeton Road.
7. Install Rip Rap near Vernal Pool where water runs off roadway naturally.

Once this section of road is completed, Highway Dept. will let it sit and settle for the winter. Mr. Gauthier's plan is to pave the 3700' next spring.
