Meeting Held August 11, 2010

Members present: Mike Stevens, Steve Mossey, Dave Klinch, Eric Gemborys, Anthony Coppola Associate, Allan Olly, Rebecca Bodja from DCR and Clerk Carol Burke No abutters were present.

7:11 p.m. Mike Stevens opened the Public Hearing filed by Hamway Engineering, Inc. of Leominster in behalf of Edward Gallant of 24 Old Boston Turnpike, Hubbardston, MA., for the proposed sewage disposal system upgrade for an existing septic system shown as Map 11C, Parcel 39 on the Assessors' maps, with Eric Gemborys seconding.

Fred Hamwey from Hamway Engineering and his daughter, Rebecca met with the Commission to present the Notice of Intent. Allan Olly asked what the schedule is that they would like to get the project done. Mr. Hamwey said they plan to have it done in the fall of 2010. The Commission members asked that in clearing the trees, they flag the working zone and use hale bales and silt fence to prevent any erosion. The members asked that local hay be used to prevent vegetation erosion. Also the members told the Hamweys that no work is to begin until the Order of Conditions is recorded with the Worcester Registry of Deeds.

After describing the project in detail, Mike Stevens made a MOTION to accept the plan as presented. Seconded: Tony Coppola and the Conservation Commission VOTED all in favor to accept the plan.

Mr. Hamwey and Ms. Hamwey left at 7:45 p.m.
